

Five (5) Basic Principles of our H&S Management System

Principle 1 - Commitment & Policy

An organisation should define its H&S Policy and ensure commitment to its H&S Management System.

Principle 2 - Planning

An organisation should plan to fulfil its H&S Policy, and H&S-related Objectives and Targets.

Principle 3 - Implementation

To implement an effective H&S Management System, an organisation must develop the capabilities, support mechanisms and provide those resources necessary to achieve the H&S Policy, Objectives and Targets established by the organisation.

Principle 4 - Measurement & Evaluation

An organisation should measure, monitor and evaluate its H&S performance, and where required, take preventative and/or remedial action while striving to achieve established H&S Objectives and Targets.

Principle 5 - Review & Improvement

Improvement in an H&S Management System can only be achieved by regularly reviewing the continued suitability of the system in the face of change (i.e. are we meeting our Objectives and Targets), and by identifying opportunities for enhancement.
