

TERMS AND CONDITIONS – VODAFONE TRAVELLER

- (a) Vodafone Traveller is available to customers connected to eligible Vodafone Postpay Caps and Plans who specifically opt-in to Vodafone Traveller. Go to vodafone.com.au or phone Customer Care for information about eligible Postpay Caps and Plans. Customers who do not opt-in to Vodafone Traveller and who use their device while roaming internationally will be charged according to Vodafone World Postpay rates; Vodafone World for Postpay is the default roaming product.
 - (b) Vodafone Traveller customers will be charged for making and receiving calls and TXT and for using other services while roaming internationally at different rates according to the geographical zone they are roaming in at the time.
 - (c) Calls made while overseas on Vodafone Traveller will be charged the roaming premium per minute rate (zone charge) plus the standard domestic call rate plus the domestic flag fall. The roaming premium per minute rate is dependent on the particular zone the call is made in at the time the call is placed. The standard domestic call rate and the flag fall are as per the applicable Cap or Plan the customer is connected to at the time. These rates apply to standard calls and TXT and toll free numbers outside Australia. Calls to numbers advertised as "Free Call" numbers within the country being visited are charged at standard rates for calls to that country.
 - (d) Calls are charged in 30 second increments with a 60 second minimum duration.
 - (e) Go to vodafone.com.au or phone Customer Care for information about specific roaming rates and charges for services such as: Vodafone live!, PXT, video calls, voicemail, Ask us anything-123, Directory Assistance-1223, 15 numbers, Premium TXT and Call Screen (Call Screen for Postpay Customers only).
 - (f) For Postpay Vodafone Traveller customers connected to a Cap or Plan, the roaming premium per minute rate (zone charge) for calls made and received, for TXT made and for all other services used will be charged as out of Cap or Plan usage. The domestic standard call rate will be included in the Cap or Plan credit.
 - (g) Customers on Postpay Vodafone Traveller can opt-in to Vodafone Traveller or change back to Vodafone World free of charge at any time.
 - (h) All calls where a connection fee (flag fall) would apply if the call had been made in Australia will incur the same connection fee (flag fall) on top of the domestic standard call rate.
 - (i) Any existing international roaming discounts will be forfeited upon connection to Vodafone Traveller.
 - (j) Vodafone Traveller customers who use GPRS while roaming will incur a charge of \$0.01 per KB with a 1KB increment and a minimum session charge of 10KB.

- (k) There are no additional access fees or monthly charges for Vodafone Traveller. Details of all calls, TXT and other services used whilst overseas will appear on the bill of your selected domestic Voice cap or Plan. Actual charges may vary on your statement as each charge is rounded up to the nearest cent. All services while roaming are GST free.
- (l) All Vodafone services, including Vodafone Traveller are subject to network availability, individual handset capabilities and limitations of overseas networks. Some Vodafone services such as TXT and Vodafone live! may not be available whilst roaming in some countries.
- (m) All Vodafone plans may be modified or withdrawn by Vodafone at any time. All prices, terms and conditions are current as of July 2008 and are subject to change.
